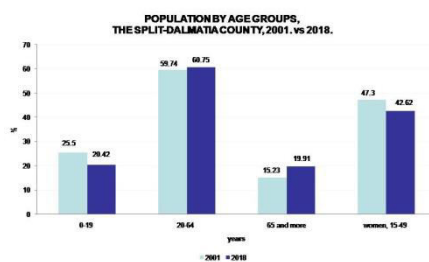
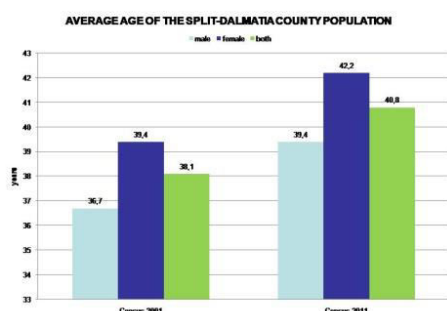
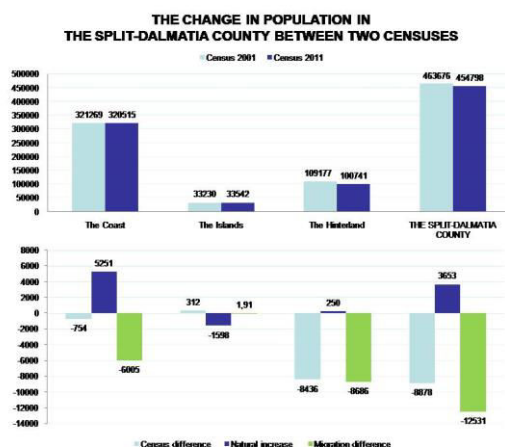
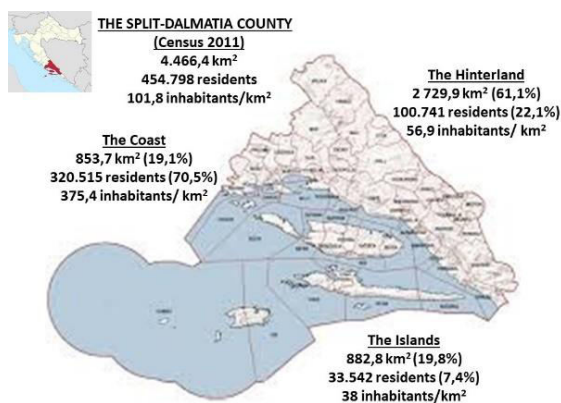
Background
